Sustaining Hospice Care thanks to community support

- Our hospice, despite being a charity, faces commercial costs similar to for-profit businesses.
- Fundraising is essential to bridge the financial gap between government funding and the actual expenses of providing palliative and end-of-life care in Taranaki.
- Nearly 85% of our operating expenditure goes towards salaries for our specialised palliative care staff.
- Donations and Grants help us recruit, retain, and recognise these crucial team members, including medical doctors, nurses, social workers, counsellors, pharmacist, and spiritual care staff.
- Community support also aids in covering essential expenses like building rent, vehicle fuel, energy costs, and property maintenance.
- At times, we may seek targeted funding to offset specific business expenses.
- We are sincerely grateful for the ongoing support from our community, which enables us to provide vital care services at no cost to anyone in need.
